Dear parent/carer,

I am pleased to announce that we have arranged for 'The Book People' to be in school for one week during the Summer term. When we hold a book fair, we can select books for school as a percentage of our sales, as you can imagine this enhances our school library with new books that all the children can share.

This year, in an attempt to fill our library with new, modern and exciting books, we are introducing a 'Book Savings Scheme' for children in KS2. We will of course review the scheme in the Summer and if it is successful, introduce it in KS1 next September.

Starting on Thursday 8th November, children can 'bank' money, in any quantity above 50 pence, to go towards purchasing books when we have our Book Fair in the Summer. Your child will be given a card that will be kept in school and all money banked will be recorded on this. When the book fair arrives they will be given time to select books which will be paid through the savings in their 'book bank' account. We are introducing this as it allows children save money slowly to buy books from the fair.

If there is anything left in your child's account after they have bought their books it will be refunded.

Books can still be purchased outright from the fair - your child does not have to have a 'book bank' account to buy books. I will send more information out about this nearer to the fair arriving.

If you would like your child to start a savings card, please return this slip by Thursday 8th November with a minimum of 50p.
